

JingleBell Jamboree Rules

1. Coaches/Managers must submit a team roster by Nov 30 at 10pm.
2. Coaches or managers are to check in with the tournament registrar's desk, located in the main lobby at the entrance to the dressing rooms, to complete their game sheets at least 30 minutes prior to game start.
3. Players benches and ice surfaces are to be strictly used by bench staff and players, that appear on the official rosters, only. Parent, fans and all other attendees are prohibited from accessing these areas.
4. All teams must, at all times, have a rostered Coach and a FEMALE Trainer present during the duration of game play.
5. Players may only participate if they are on the official registered team roster and are the appropriate age for their division.
6. Players and coaches are required to be in the rink and ready to start play at least fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled game time. Players and coaches are expected to co-operate in keeping the arenas and dressing rooms clean and tidy and are liable for any vandalism or damage.
7. All games will be played half ice with the use of half ice boards with small nets.
8. Ice pads divided up into "South" end close to the Zamboni entrance and "North" end close to the ATTACK entrance.
9. Blue 4oz pucks will be used for U7 games. Black 6oz pucks will be used for U9 games.
10. U9 Games will consist of 4 on 4 with a goalie. U7 Games will consist of 5 on 5 with a goalie. In the event that a team does not have a goalie present, the net will remain empty and a 5th skater may be added. For safety reasons, no player shall occupy the net without the necessary equipment.
11. Goalie equipment must be ice rated (road hockey/ ball hockey equipment is not permitted).
12. Both games are to be synchronized using the same clock. Games are 2 periods of 20 minutes, non-stop clock.
13. Game lengths will be running time with a buzzer signaling every 2 minutes for line changes.

14. On the buzzer, players must relinquish control of the puck immediately and vacate the ice. The new players enter the ice immediately.
15. Face-offs are used at the start of each period.
16. Teams will be given 3 minutes to get on the ice and warm-up prior to starting the game and 2 minute between periods.
17. No stoppage of play after a goal, the scoring team must retreat to the vicinity of their net and cannot pressure until the attacking team reaches mid ice.
18. Goaltender freezes the puck - the official blows the whistle to indicate the attacking team to back off three meters and the defending team takes possession.
19. There will be no score kept.
20. There will be NO Penalties, however if a player is being unruly, they may be asked to leave the ice for a shift or the remainder of the game.
21. In all U7/U9 Jamboree games all players are to be treated fairly with respect to ice time distribution and situational opportunities.
22. All Coaching Staff, Players, Parents, Fans and other Attendees are reminded that the on ice officials are volunteers from within the Minor Hockey Community. Any complaints or observations of verbal abuse or harassment of any on ice officials will result in that person being immediately removed from the rink.
